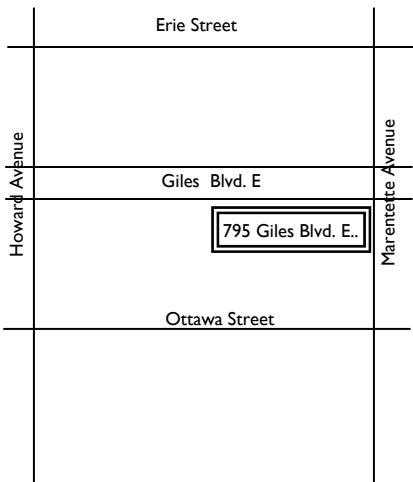


How do I get there?

Leadership Development Program

Family Support Co-Facilitation

A leadership development education opportunity for parents and community members.

Participants will:

Complete a six week leadership course in family support co-facilitation. Upon completion participants may be offered a variety of opportunities to co-facilitate future Connections Early Years Family Centre courses/groups.

Requirements:

Participants will be expected to:

- Sign an Agreement of Understanding
- Commit to co-facilitate future parenting courses/groups
- Provide a criminal reference check prior to co-facilitating a course or group
- Attend a relevant Connections EYFC parenting course/group/workshop
- Complete the volunteer application/orientation process
- Have post secondary education

* priority will be given to participants with long term interest/participation in the Centre

Benefits to Participants:

- Enhance public speaking skills in a relaxed environment
- Increase leadership skills
- Enhance knowledge base in family support
- Increase capacity to provide peer support
- Receive a certificate of completion
- Access to additional training

Participants who have successfully completed the course:

- May be approached to co-facilitate a Connections EYFC parenting course/group/workshop
- May be offered other family support leadership opportunities
- May receive an honorarium for their services

Connections EYFC will:

- Commit to providing a 6 week leadership development course
- Provide support and guidance during course time
- Maintain attendance
- Provide resources and materials free of charge
- Issue certificates of completion
- Offer V.E.E.R. program

Participants will:

- Sign a confidentiality statement
- Understand that the Leadership Development Program is specific to Connections EYFC and the services we provide to families at the Centre
- Understand that opportunities offered to participants are at the discretion of Connections EYFC
- Read and follow course ground rules as established by the facilitator
- Commit to promoting the values and principles of course material and Connections EYFC
- Abide by the policies and procedures of Connections EYFC
- Receive a certificate upon completion of the course
