Our Mission

To provide support, resources, and individualized services to promote the early learning and healthy development of families and their young children (0 - 6 years).

SERVICES AND PROGRAMS

EarlyON Child & Family Centre

Supportive programming, including Come & Play sessions and parenting courses and groups that strengthen bonds and foster the well-being, engagement, and expression of parents, caregivers, and children 0 - 6 years of age.

Talk 2 Me Preschool Speech and Language Program

Resources and programs for children with speech and language concerns from birth until school entry, working closely with parents and caregivers.

Infant Hearing Program

Universal newborn hearing screening, high risk monitoring and services for children identified with a permanent hearing loss.

Be Back Soon Program

No-cost, unlicensed short-term child care for families with children 0-6 years of age living with low income to attend job interviews, training, medical, legal, social service, and counselling appointments.

Blind Low Vision Early Intervention Program

Services for children who are blind or have low vision and their families, including family support, intervention, and consultation services.

Ontario Autism Program's Caregiver-Mediated Early Years Programs

Programs for parents with children 12-48 months registered in the OAP to learn therapeutic strategies and techniques from professionals in the areas of social communications and play.

Building UP! An Inclusive, Accessible, and Energy-Efficient Space for Families and Young Children

Our multi-phase renovation plan has guided us in completing these upgrades while ensuring we continue to deliver the same quality of service to families.




How will your donation be recognized?
